Minutes – June 11, 2019

Call to Order– Flag Pledge at 8 p.m. with all members present.

Dennis will call for rock and see if they can lock in a price for now to complete this fall or next year. Other issues to be fixed – Spec Lake, Cobalt has a bad culvert, doesn't drain correctly and Rhinestone – has hole in road above culvert. Chloride has to be ordered a year in advance. The township will wait to see if some of the dirt roads need it this year.
