

Wyanett Township Regular Monthly Meeting

Minutes – August 21, 2018

Call to Order – 8:05 P.M. – Flag Pledge

Present - all Absent

Minutes of 7-10-18 Regular Monthly Meeting were approved on motion by Travis, 2nd Ken and passed.

Treasurer's Report – Travis so moved to not read all the entries with Ken the 2nd passed. Cathy read her report. Ken so moved to approve with Travis, 2nd, passed.

Visitors - 6 present. Gary Kneeland requested reported cracks in his road on the East side of Stanchifeld. This fall the chip sealer machine will fix that.

Century Link approval – Dennis Haubenschild, Jessica Anderson – Travis made the motion to approve, with Ken the 2nd – passed.

Michael Taylor Driveway permit – cost of address sign – resolution? After discussion the township will continue to pay for the address signs.

Possible scams to clerks and treasurers – per advisement from MAT – ignore for now. They are requesting personal data of employees.

2019 certified town aid notice - \$2,448 will be the 2019 amount coming to us.

Dennis did a 3 hour tour with the weed inspector. Most of the weeds to be removed are on the county roads. Tom will address our weeds as he comes to them.

Justin is about half way done with the town hall project. Cathy requested landings be made by the steps on both sides. Discussion on sidewalk between both areas. Travis suggested to put the cement all around the building to correct any moisture problems. Cathy reported sewer pipes are sticking up.

Regarding the 8-7-18 Princeton Fire Board meeting – most of the townships including ours are opposed to being assessed for the Princeton Fire Board suggestion to split the cost of a new engine and a used ladder truck for a cost of one million dollars to be spread out for 9 years which would raise our premium by 60%. All township budgets have been set for 2019 already. Discussions will continue at the next Fire Board meetings. Our township gave a one time 6% in 2018 to help them already with expenses.
