Isanti County Cares Grant – Linda handling this – Due Nov. 10th

Linda delivered it to Chad on 11-6 -2020. \$934.10 was the allowable amount to be reimbursed for election expenses due to the Covid.

Cares Act Funding – Barb Prince is handling this. The last 5 five checks were written to finish out her report. Ken so moved to buy a hot water pressure washer to sanitize the fire trucks from Dalbo and Princeton and 1^{st} responder vehicles and the maintenance building. Travis – 2^{nd} passed. The cost was \$4,599. Ken so moved to approve \$1,000 checks to the Princeton Pantry Food Shelf and Cambridge Surplus Foods, Dennis the 2^{nd} , passed. Ken so moved to give \$5,000 donation to Dalbo Fire Dept.to purchase radios less people would be using the same radio and it be safer with the Covid , Dennis 2^{nd} , passed. Barb stated the balance of \$101.17 will be sent back to Isanti Co Auditor. Dennis so moved to approve, Ken – 2^{nd} – passed.

New Business -
