Minutes –November 12, 2024

Call to Order– Flag Pledge - the whole board was present.

Minutes – 11-12-24 - Regular Meeting Minutes were approved on motion by Travis, 2nd by Dennis. Passed.

Treasurer's Report – Ken so moved with Travis 2nd not to read all the entries. Travis so moved with Dennis 2nd to approve the report. Passed.

Visitors - 4 – Steve Zamberse introduced himself as the new Princeton Fire Dept. chief. He gave an update on what brought him to the Princeton area.

Michael Anderson is eager to start snowplowing for the township again.

Old Business - Bd of Appeal Training – Dennis will get this done soon so he is ready for 2025.

CTAS update – Dennis will also do this soon.

New Business – snowplowing notice approval for 2025 – Travis read the notice for the end of 2024 and all of 2025. Dennis so moved to approve with Travis, 2nd, passed.

Road mileage approval was approved by Dennis, 2nd by Travis, passed. Travis will take to the details to the Highway Dept. and make sure they put a couple of details on the map that were approved last year. They also reviewed the culvert structures by the Highway Dept. and he will check with them on some details with that as well.

Voter turnout details for Nov. 5, 2024 were read by Linda supplied by Isanti County to us. Wyanett had 1,348 registered with 1,248 voting. The voters at the hall were 969 with 77 new registrations. Wyanett has a good team of election judges and that makes for a successful election experience for all.

Ken will meet with Grant Lindberg on Dec. 9th at his office in St. Cloud to discuss the Princeton Township details.

Ken brought back a Princeton Fire Dept. contract with a new formula for computing charges due each township. Ken said it is incomplete for Wyanett's situation and when it is redone our lawyer will read it over before we sign.

Travis gave a Dalbo Fire Dept. update on things going on there.
